

## Call for Papers and Panels

# 10-12 March 2016, Faculty of Social and Human Sciences – University Nova of Lisbon

All interested in presenting panels and papers at the VIII Conference of the Portuguese Political Science Association (APCP) should submit their proposal until **18<sup>th</sup> October 2015** by email to <u>congressos@apcp.pt</u>

Proposals should not exceed 200 WORDS and must include the following information:

- 1. Section title
- 2. Title of the paper
- 3. Author's full name
- 4. Author's institutional affiliation and position
- 5. Author's email address
- 6. Short abstract of the submission

Proposals should also include BRIEF CURRICULUM VITAE (max. 150 words).

APCP will accept per speaker 2 proposals (1 as individual and 1 as co-author).

In cases where a single author submits several papers for appreciation these should be sent in the same document.

The panel proposals should include a title, a moderator and the respective papers. The latter should include the above requirements for individual papers.

The conference will include the following sections:

Section 1: Portuguese society and politics Section 2: European studies Section 3: Comparative politics Section 4: Governance and public policy Section 5: International relations Section 6: Political theory

Submissions are open to all interested parties, with the final selection being based solely on academic criteria. Preference will be given to the submission of panels, i. e., group of papers subordinated in a coherent way to a given theme.
